All registration forms must be completed online.

Log onto www.necna.com to register. You should print your online confirmation of registration and mail it with your payment/Purchase Order. As a convenience, a credit card option is available online.

If multiple members of one department are attending, each individual must be registered online individually.

All registrations must be made online by March 6, 2010 to avoid a late fee. A \$25.00 late fee will be assessed after this date.

Agencies paying by Purchase Order must satisfy payment by April 9, 2010, to guarantee seating.

Any payments, regardless of registration date, not satisfied by April 26, 2010, will be assessed an additional \$25.00 collection fee per each individual registrant. NO EXCEPTIONS.
